AFS Communication 4/2019 dated 20 May 2019 (AFS 2020 ACTIVITIES AND PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE) has reference.

Due to a lack of response to abovementioned Communication, it is of utmost importance to bring the following again under your attention, Act 2 of 2010, IAAF Rules and ASA Rules as published in the 2020 - 2021 ATHLETICS SOUTH AFRICA (ASA) DOMESTIC COMPETITION RULES. APPROVED AT ASA AGM 23 JUNE 2019 (IN FORCE WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT). These ASA Competition Rules are applicable for athletics competitions held in South Africa under the auspices of ASA.

It is the responsibility of each member to familiarize him / her self with Act 2 of 2010, IAAF and ASA Rules. These documents are also on the different web-sites available to download.

SASREA and IAAF and ASA Rules:

In terms of the IAAF and ASA Rules as well as SASREA (Act 2 of 2010) the following will be implemented with immediate effect and is not negotiable.

1. The following Delegates must be appointed by the Event Organiser and confirmed to AFS for all approved athletics events:

- 1.1 AFS Delegate. Will be appointed by AFS
- 1.2 Medical Delegate. The Event Organiser must liaise with ER24 for the appointment of the Medical Delegate.
- 1.3 Security Officer. The Event Organiser must liaise with Senforce for the appointment of the Security Officer for all events at the MAS and CC hosted by AFS at Kovsie CC track.

ASA Rules Concerning the Activities please see the following Rules:

ASA Rule 13: The Eligible Competition / Race Organiser.

Rule 21: New Competitions.

21.7 No new competitions for the following year will be listed on the ASA Provincial Fixtures lists after October of the preceding year. Provinces may host such additional competitions, with the condition that the competition will not be covered by the ASA athlete medical insurance. This restriction must be stated on the promotional material.

Annual Schedule for SAPS General

1. The SAPS Schedule must be submitted with your Activities Request for all activities hosted on the Mangaung Athletics Stadium (MAS). Without the SAPS Schedule the booking of the MAS will not be done.
2. For events not on the MAS, each Event Organiser is responsible for submitting the SAPS Schedule plus the necessary documents required according to SASREA to the SAPS

Due to above-mentioned, the following timelines must be adhered to:

Clubs must submit their final activities for 2020 to the AFS Office before or on **Friday 06 September 2019**.

Commissions must approve their 2020 activities and submit their final activities to the AFS office before or on **Friday 13 September 2019**.

AFS final 2020 Activity list will be submitted to ASA on **27 September 2019** (ASA Circular 53 of 2019).

Event Organisers must submit the documents to the SAPS as prescribed in SASREA.
