1. It came to the attention of Athletics Free State that events not approved by AFS or ASA is advertised in the media and social media, with specific reference to:

- 1.1 Mpho Charl Botha Diabetic Foundation events on 30 November 2019 at the Matjhabeng Clock Tower Welkom
- 1.2 GI JOE events on 07 December 2019 in Virginia.

2. Athletics Free State again want to bring the following under the attention of our members:

3. Events not reflected on the activity lists of ASA or Provincial Federations is not sanctioned and therefore ineligible events.

4. We draw your attention to the 2020 - 2021 ATHLETICS SOUTH AFRICA (ASA) DOMESTIC COMPETITION RULES APPROVED AT ASA AGM 23 JUNE 2019, in particular to the following:

- 4.1 ASA Rule 1.3 Any athletics competitions not listed on ASA National and Provincial Fixtures Lists may be declared ineligible. Any licensed athlete participating in such competition may be declared ineligible. See Rule 5

4.2 ASA Rule 5.2 An athlete is eligible to compete in South Africa, or any other IAAF Member country if he/she is in possession of an ASA License, agrees to abide by the rules of ASA, or IAAF where relevant, and has not been declared ineligible by ASA or IAAF.

4.3 ASA Rule 13: The Eligible Competition / Race Organiser
[Refer IAAF Rules 121 to 124 and ASA Constitution Clause 28]

4.4 It is of utmost importance to familiarize yourself with all the rules and regulations.

5. Clubs please advise your members accordingly and request them to refrain from taking part in races not approved by ASA and Provincial Federations. Athletes to have taken part in any ineligible race will be disciplined and will be declared ineligible.
