1. This is a planning and working activity list for 2021 only for the AFS Board and Commissions and not to be distributed (see attached).
2. This is done according to the ASA 2021 planning activities (see ASA Circular 17 of 2020 attached).
3. The possible AFS activities is marked in orange for further planning.
4. This is also a good time for Associated Members to allocate a member to each of the Commissions; FS PS, FS HS, FSSAPD and FS Masters. Schools must look at a member on the AFS RR Commission to start a Schools League.
5. The dates are done with the assumption that entries for the National T&F and XC Championships had to be submitted 14 days before the Championship.
6. The AFS XC Leagues where the schools form part of the leagues, athletes must be licensed. Participation will be in their schools' attire or according WA & ASA rules concerning competition attire.
7. The AFS RR Leagues where the schools form part of the leagues, athletes must be licensed. Participation will be in their schools' attire or according WA & ASA rules concerning competition attire.
8. At all the AFS (Provincial) Championships all athletes must be licensed. Participation will be in their schools' attire or according WA & ASA rules concerning competition attire.
9. At all the ASA / AFS Competitions & Championships, from Inter Provincial Competitions, all athletes must be licensed. Participation will only be in the AFS attire.
10. All the events on the AFS (Provincial) and ASA activity lists are eligible, therefore the WA, ASA and AFS rules will be applicable.
11. At all the T&F events up to and including District level the different Schools structurers will be responsible for all the arrangements as currently the case. Athletes need not to be licensed and participation will be in their schools' attire or according WA & ASA rules concerning competition attire.

For the AFS Primary Schools Championship and the FS Inter High, the Schools structure stays responsible for all the arrangements and the AFS Representative / Technical Delegate will form part of the Championship / Competition according the WA & ASA rules. Athletes must be licensed. Participation will be in their schools' attire or according WA & ASA rules concerning competition attire.
13. Abovementioned is only a few rulings and ideas to take athletics forward and give our athletes all the opportunities possible to be prepared and perform at their best.
14. It must be mentioned that the Associated Members, especially the Schools structurers will be more involved and AFS will rely more on them for more competition opportunities for mass participation, development, preparation to the different higher competitions and championships.
15. The Commissions must allocate the responsible person for each Championship. This person is not replacing the Technical Delegate, the Technical Delegates will be appointed by the different Commissions in co-operation with the Technical Committee as soon as the 2021 activity list is finalized.
16. The Road Running Commission must determine the different events incorporating the FS Championship, as some event organizers feel they do not want to incorporate the FS Championship as they did it for the last few years. Also distribute the different Championships throughout the FS, or come up with a solution to give as much of our athletes a change to participate in the FS Championships.
17. Please send your feedback to me before Thursday 16 April 2020 to finalize our Activity list and submit it to ASA before 30 April 2020.
