2. The following Rules and Regulations are still in place and must be adhered to:
 - 2.1 No training will be allowed without a written booking well in advance, five (5) working days before the training session (see attached).
 - 2.2 After receipt of 2021 licenses, only licensed persons will be allowed to train and enter the stadium. You will be informed when licenses are available.
 - 2.3 MAS Training Rules (see attached).
 - 2.4 Covid 19 Rules and Regulations. To name a few:
 - Sanitising
 - Wearing of masks
 - Social distancing
 - Stay in the open
 - Personal hygiene
 - 2.5 The following documents must be handed to the Compliance Officer before any person can enter the stadium.
 - Health questionnaire (see attached)
 - AFS Tracking Visitors Log (see attached)

- 2.6 Only persons on the abovementioned two (2) forms will be allowed in the stadium.
- 2.7 Only two training sessions per coach / athlete will be allowed per week. We need to give all our athletes the opportunity to train at the stadium.
- 2.8 Training sessions will not exceed two (2) hours per coach / athlete.
- 2.9 Clubs / Coaches will be held liable for the payment of overtime and taxi fees for sessions not attended without cancellations in writing well in advance one (1) day (24 hours).
- 2.10 Clubs / Coaches will receive an invoice at the end of each month for training sessions during the mentioned month.
- 2.11 The invoice must be settled within five (5) days of the date of the invoice.
- 2.12 No one is allowed to share / post photos, remarks, etc. of the training sessions on social media, this will lead to the cancellation of all training sessions (all training on the MAS will be suspended with immediate effect).
- 2.13 Not adhering to all the Rules and Regulations inside the stadium, will lead to the loss of the privilege to train on the stadium.
- 2.14 No training will be allowed during the 72-hour cleaning period before and after and event on the stadium.
