**Additional information: AFS T&F League 6: 18 September 2021:**

Due to the relaxation of the Covid Level to Adjusted Alert Level 2 with new Rules and Regulations the following Rules and Regulations will be implemented and effective from AFS League 6 on 18 September 2021:

1. The scanning area will only be at the Northern gate (Waterfront side).
2. Athletes from 18 years and younger can be accompanied by one parent and the athlete's coach.
3. A separate scanning area will be available for the parents and coaches.
4. Parents will only be allowed up to the warm-up area and only the athlete and coach will be allowed in warm-up area. Parents must move to the embankment area.
5. The athlete, coach and parent must leave the stadium immediately at the Northern Gate (Kovsie Gate) after the athlete's event is finished.
6. The cost for a coach or parent to enter the stadium will be R30 for the duration of the specific event. This is to assist AFS with the cost to implement and achievement of Covid 19 Rules and Regulations. Due to the Covid Rules and Regulations, the coach affiliation card is not valid for entry.

7. No spectators are allowed in the stadium, the pavilion, West and North of the competition area is out of bounds, therefore any person on the pavilion, West and North of the competition area is seen as not adhering to Covid 19 Rules and Regulations. Any person in these areas will be asked to leave the stadium. People not adhering to these Covid Rules and Regulations commits an offence and will be handled according Government Gazette, Regulation Gazette No 11337 Vol 675 dated 12 September 2021 No 45156.

8. The walk-are at the back of the seating at the Western side will only be used to go to the Warm-up area and to leave the stadium.

9. Coaches are allowed one gazebo in the warm-up area only against the Northern fence between the warm-up area and the competition area. Sanitizer must be provided by the coach and, sanitization, social distancing, wearing of masks (all Covid Rules and Regulations) must be adhered to. Not adhering to the Rules and Regulations the coach will be asked to remove the gazebo.

10. No parking in South parking area from At Horak Street will be allowed.

9. All Covid 19 Rules and Regulations must always be adhered to and if necessary, AFS pertain the right to only allow those coaches and parents that can provide proof of vaccination into the stadium.
